The Stock Option Plan of the Corporation was amended to change the maximum number of common shares reserved for issuance pursuant to the Plan from 3,324,400 to a varying number equal to up to ten percent (10%) of the issued and outstanding common shares of the Corporation at and given time.

Wycliffe is a junior resource company focused on the exploration and development of mining properties in Northern Ontario. Wycliffe is specifically focused on diamond exploration and is one of the largest land holders in the Attawapiskat region of the James Bay Lowlands.
